Reimbursement is determined by the resident undergraduate base tuition, and applicable differential tuition, charged by the University of WI-Madison or the tuition rate at the student's qualifying school, whichever is less. This grant will be suspended if the student is AWOL or flagged & denied if the student is delinquent in child support or maintenance payments s. 49.854(2)(b), WI Stats.



- I just joined the Wisconsin National Guard. How long do I have to wait to be eligible to apply for the WING Tuition Grant? Do I have to complete Basic and AIT before being eligible?
 - ➤ Once you enlist in the Wisconsin National Guard you can begin drilling with the unit you are assigned to. The requirement is that you are an actively drilling member of the WI National Guard upon the date of completion of course. Completion of military training is not required to begin using the Grant. However, if you fail to complete training and are subsequently discharged from the WING, any Grants awarded to you will be recouped.
- I am going to ETS, transfer branches/states, or commission before the end of the term. Can I still receive the Grant for my last term?
 - ➤ No! The requirement is that you are an actively drilling member of the WI National Guard upon the date of completion of course. This benefit was set up as a recruiting and retention tool. You cannot receive the Grant if you are no longer an <u>enlisted</u> actively drilling member of the Wisconsin National Guard on the last date of the term/course.
- A Student wants to attend or transfer to an out of state school, will they still be eligible to receive the WING Grant?
 - ➤ All State of Minnesota Schools (UMN and Tech) and a handful of schools in Illinois, Michigan and Iowa have Reciprocity agreements with WI, but beyond that, NO. Any Private Out-of-State schools do not qualify.



I did not obtain a 2.0, should I bother applying for the Grant?
OR

I received an incomplete or I am flagged for PT, Weight or AWOL - should I wait until I receive a complete or Flag removal to send in an application?

Submit your application at the end of the original term, regardless of obtaining a 2.0, receiving an incomplete, or being flagged. The application **must** be received within 90 days of the end of the **original** term. If you wait, your application could be rejected as late. If the low GPA for the semester is later adjusted, or the incomplete is later completed satisfactorily, the school should send in an amended original application, and it will be re-processed!

• If I take a Summer/Winter Term, or attend less than a full semester, will it negatively impact the amount of Grant I am eligible for?

➤ No! A member is eligible to use 120 credits of part-time study or 8 **full** semesters of full-time study (12+ credits) – whichever occurs first. Anything less than 12 credits is pro-rated as part time study and does not count against the member as a full semester. A term ≠ a full semester.

- A student is enrolled in a study abroad program. Are they eligible to receive the Wisconsin National Guard Tuition Grant?
 - > As long as the study abroad program is run through a qualified school, in which the payment is made to the qualified school and the certifying official can verify the credits and GPA.
- Why is Direct Deposit not an option?
 - ➤ Payments through the state are completed one of two ways. Through Human Resources as income (which the Grant is not), or through Finance as a payment. Direct Deposit in the Finance module requires an individual be set up as a "Supplier" in the State System requiring a W9, a New Supplier Form, and a Voided check be entered for each student. Each time a student moves or changes financial institutions, new forms are required.
- I plan to move at the end of the semester, what address should I list?
 - ➤ It is always recommended that you provide a more permanent address, ie. parent or trusted contact. This reduces the risk of forwarding issues and returned as undeliverable mail.
- I live in an Apartment; do I need to include the Apartment number in my address?
 - > Yes! Without the Apartment Number, your check may be returned as undeliverable.



- I received other benefits or financial aid to assist in Education expenses, will this count against the amount of Wisconsin National Guard Tuition Grant I receive?
 - > It depends on the benefit:

> YES:

If the benefit, or aid received does not require repayment AND is required to be used specifically towards tuition payment, then it must be applied to the tuition first and <u>subtracted</u> from the total "out of pocket tuition paid by student" prior to the WING Tuition Grant being awarded.

Examples include:

- o Post-9/11 GI Bill (Ch. 33)
- Federal Tuition Assistance
- Air Force Tuition Assistance
- Tuition Scholarship

> NO:

If the benefit or aid received requires repayment or can be used for other than tuition costs, such as books, room and board, supplies.

Examples include:

- o GI Bill 1606 (Montgomery GI Bill)
- Pell Grant
- Federal Supplemental
 Educational Opportunity Grants
 (FSEOG)
- Student Loans

> WI GI Bill and VetEd benefit recipients are not eligible to receive the WING Tuition Grant
